

SAMEA 2022 Online Capacity Building Workshops

Special workshop rate for Emerging Evaluators

SAMEA is offering a special workshop rate to Emerging Evaluators to attend our 2022 Online Capacity Building Workshops, in line with our values and mission statement. A discounted rate of **R300** for a full workshop session aims to support emerging evaluators who have a demonstrable interest in M&E and a desire to increase their knowledge on key M&E related themes. Full-time or part-time post-graduate students are also encouraged to apply. The awarding of the special rates will be at the discretion of the SAMEA selection panel.

Requirements:

If you would like to apply to participate in the June online workshops as an Emerging Evaluator, you must meet the following requirements:

- Be a part-time; full-time student or unemployed in a field with an M&E Component, preferably post-graduate and/or be an emerging evaluator through future career plans;
- Be an individual whose field work or area of interest is M&E focussed.
- Successful applicants will be expected to submit a one-page Feedback Report on their workshop experience. This will be featured on the SAMEA website after the workshops have concluded.

Preference will be given to:

- SAMEA members in good standing (i.e your student membership should be active).
- Historically disadvantaged individuals, women, youth and the disabled.

Application process:

To be considered for this special workshop rate, you will need to provide the following:

1. Write a short motivation (250 words maximum) stating why you should be awarded this opportunity
2. A CV, inclusive of the following:
 - Full names, contact details
 - Qualifications
 - Career objective
 - Work experience, present affiliation and title
