

10 institutional members-Highest number thus far






Membership (Jan – Oct 2016)

- After the incoming board decision to reduce the SAMEA employee structure to just one post, a revised employment contract and job description was drafted for the post of Project Administrator.
- The key performance areas and indicators of the post were adopted by the board; and an interim performance review reflected satisfaction with the progress which the current employee.
- Given our board's commitment to membership satisfaction, it is recommended that an opportunity is created soon for SAMEA members to rate the administrative service levels which they are currently receiving, together with requests for enhanced services.

Develop clear research agenda and facilitate commencement of 4 studies

- A research partnership has been forged between CLEAR-AA,
 CREST and SAMEA
- Clear set of research topics have been identified
- Funding for up to 4 studies has been secured
- Call for proposals has been issued and promoted locally & on BetterEvaluation.Org.
- So far we have received 6 proposals and anticipate more by 14 October deadline.



Development of frameworks on ethics, standards and competencies

- A draft of a SAMEA position paper on evaluation ethics and standards has been developed to be considered by the Board during October 2016.
- Task teams to be developed to assist with this process.
 Request for members to participate:
 - Ethics and Standards Task team
 - Competency Task team
- Once revised and approved, it will be circulated for comment by members and formally adopted during 2017.



Partnerships with evaluation stakeholders are forged & sustained

- There has been progress in this area but it has been uneven,
 e.g, our efforts to support the AEJ have not been successful.
- We are working on re-energising our relationship with our key government partners.
- We had a successful SAMEA-AEA Partnership Program which sought to provide a platform for the SA evaluation community to engage with the idea of developing competencies for the country and review what we currently have in place.
- Dr Laurie Stevahn's visit was also intended to strengthen the visibility of SAMEA and offer our members and the broader evaluation community a capacity development opportunity.



SAMEA Financial status

- SAMEA aims to maintain a healthy financial balance of R1 million year on year (as determined in 2012 / 2013)
- 2016 FY began with a cash balance of R 1 179 358
- Ended the financial year with a balance of R 911 636
- 2016 FY had an additional SAMEA Secretariat staff member, increasing operating cost for that year (Secretariat is now down to one staff again)
- 2017 FY looks to be on track even in absence of conference year currently ahead of 2016 FY balance
- Board has determined that membership fee should increase to due inflation and we propose R420/individual membership, R100 / student membership – fees have not increased since prior to 2012



Financial Administration & Auditors

- Treasurer hand-over occurred in May 2016
- Boshoff are the SAMEA Auditors and book keepers
- Have been our auditors for more than three years however; @ Special Meeting, quorum confirmed that it wouldn't be prudent to change auditors mid-year
- Will collect quotes to potentially change Auditors in new FY (for FY 2018 from March 2017)



Financial Planning

- In preparation for Strategic Planning to occur in January 2017, work stream budgets will be prepared so that improved spending can enhance member services
- Work stream budgeting will also facilitate fundraising efforts as potential funders will have specific 'projects' to support
- For conference 2017 sponsorship tiers and packages will be developed and 'sold' in effort to generate increased partnerships and funding from a more diverse set of partners
- SAMEA main bank balance will be moved into a higher interest bearing account given our total balance, while also keeping an account for monthly transactions



Board Election results - 2016

Board Elections

- March 2014 2 new board members elected outside of AGM cycle due to resignations
- Two board members term ends in March 2017
- Intention is to streamline board member elections with AGM cycle.
- Proposal to have an extension of 2 board members terms to October 2017.
